[HOUSTON, TEXAS, February 19, 2019—] On Wednesday at 2:00 PM, Horizon demolished the original Frenchy's Chicken location in the heart of the Third Ward. The Houston favorite moved to a temporary home, down the street, in order to accommodate the Wheeler Avenue Baptist Church Campus Expansion.

Horizon is the Church's Owner's Representative, overseeing this \$26M project. The design and construction brings together famed African American architect, Phil Freelon of Perkin + Will, with two Houston companies, Horizon as the Owner's Representative and Tellepsen as the General Contractor.

The sendoff was attended by the Church's founder, Reverend Bill Lawson, Rosalind "Mama Frenchy" Creuzot, Al Kashani, Horizon Principal and over 50 parishioners. Frenchy's and Horizon catered the event.

"Frenchy's is a defining flavor of Houston. I spent many study nights at their tables and we are excited to work with Percy "King" Creuzot III to give the original location a proper sendoff, with the respect it deserves," said Al Kashani, Horizon Principal.

Frenchy's is a Houston Landmark established in 1969 by Percy "Frenchy" Creuzot, Jr. Like its slogan states, it's "the taste that lasts forever," so does this Houston institution. Frenchy's has grown to become a hometown favorite over the years with a full Creole-style menu to accompany the infamous Frenchy's Chicken which Houstonians have come to know and love. Frenchy's is temporarily located at 4646 Scott Street.
